

On October 27th, 2013 was published in the BOCM, the Decree 76/2013, September 26<sup>th</sup>, by the Governing Council of Madrid Region, by virtue of which the free working days are fixed for the year 2014 to the Madrid Region.

There are established a total of 12 free working days, Corpus Christi included, which is fixed for June 19<sup>th</sup>. The most important novelty is that there are not free working days passed to Mondays.

In addition to the 10 free working days established for whole the country, there are two free working days corresponding to the Region of Madrid Celebration, on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and the abovementioned Corpus Christi.

The list of the free working days is the following:

January 1<sup>st</sup>, (Wednesday), New Year Day.  
January 6<sup>th</sup>, (Wednesday), Epiphany of the Lord.  
April 17<sup>th</sup>, (Thursday), Maundy Thursday.  
April 18<sup>th</sup>, (Friday), Maundy Friday.  
May 1<sup>st</sup> (Thursday), Workers day.  
May 2<sup>nd</sup>, (Friday), Region of Madrid Day.  
June 19<sup>th</sup>, (Thursday), Corpus Christi  
August 15<sup>th</sup>, (Friday), Assumption of the Virgin.  
November 1<sup>st</sup>, (Saturday), All Saints Day.  
December 6<sup>th</sup>, (Saturday), Spanish Constitution Day.  
December 8<sup>th</sup>, (Monday), Day of the Virgin's Immaculate Conception.  
December 25<sup>th</sup>, (Thursday), Nativity of the Lord.

In addition to the twelve abovementioned free working days, each city shall be entitled to fix any other two.
